I think it's common for society to look upon students in Alternative Learning Centers as "bad" kids - kicked out for behavior reasons or "juvenile delinquents" when for most of them it simply means the traditional setting didn't work for them. I did initial practicums in an ALC, later I taught one year in a self-contained classroom for a small group of students in an ALC-type environment, and then later still, had many students in my online teaching job who were learning through an ALC program. While Pink's song is about youth in general, it speaks to me especially for students who are easily forgotten.

#### The Outsiders - NEEDTOBREATHE
